Après-Ski Davos Klosters

Bolgenplaza, the No.1 après-ski rendezvous

The Bolgen Plaza is at the foot of the Jakobshorn at the Bolgen areal, right next to the superpipe near the downhill piste and cross-country ski run. The Plaza is most certainly one of the Davos après-ski hot spots, a great place to meet for a relaxing drink after an action-packed day on the pistes or dancing into the late evening to DJ sounds. In addition to seating for 150 and a snowbar, the spacious terrace has 44 beach chairs that offer an invitation to bask in the last rays of the sun while enjoying a coffee laced with schnapps.

Keen snowboarders can also pursue their passion from 19.00 h to 21.30 h. The superpipe is floodlit every evening for extra training sessions and general use. The pipe is freshly prepared every Tuesday and Thursday. Tel: +41 (0)81 413 58 18, www.bolgenplaza.ch



Jatz Hut, après-ski 1000m above Davos



The Jatz Hut, 2530 metres above sea level, is right next to the top station of the JATZ-Quattro chairlift on Jakobshorn. The hut is also easy to reach with a 10-minute-walk from the summit. Parties in the Jatz Hut start earlier than usual, at 14.30 h, with DJs and table dancing on the main terrace. The sun shines until late afternoon and the stunning views can be admired until sunset. Drinks are

Cabanna Club Davos

Probably the best-known Davos club is right in the town centre and can boast a glorious past as one of the best member clubs in the entire Alpine region. The golden Cabanna Member Card was once one of the most sought-after souvenirs of a Davos holiday. Today the club is open to all nightlife lovers and has lost none of its power of attraction. Champagne on ice is a firm favourite; guests have the choice of 20 assorted whiskies and can also order a Russian Stolichnaya vodka – unique in Davos. Chämi Bar

On the Promenade directly above the ice stadium, the Chämi Bar is not just a popular place to meet after an exciting ice-hockey evening. The typical guest is somewhere between 20 and 65 years old! The bar is fitted out in solid wood, lending a cosy chalet atmosphere. And in addition to a variety of cocktails, good food is also on the menu. From 18.00 h, tarte flambée is served from the "Chämi-Ofen" (chimney oven), which dates from the time of a former bakery. Chicken nuggets, garlic bread and hot and cold snacks are also served until 02.00 h. In addition to concerts, table football and table hockey, the bar also has a vibrant mix of music, which can get a little louder after 22.00 h but still remains in the background. (From 18.00 to 03.00 h).

Bolgenschanze

In 1993, Europe's first hotel for snowboarders was created on the Bolgenschanze. Over the years, the



hotel has become a cult bar linked to an accommodation and hotel wing and the Bolgenschanze is now one of the top trend bars in Davos. Its success is due not least to the many impressive and top-rate concert events and DJ acts, now famous far beyond Swiss borders. The Bolgenschanze is open on Monday to Thursday from 20.00 to 01.00 h, Fridays and Saturdays to 03.00 h. The daily happy hour with special prices for beer, long drinks and happy shots is from 20.000 to 21.30 h. (Admission from age 18).
