Schools – Ticket regulations

Welcome to the Davos Klosters Mountains

We warmly welcome school groups to the Davos Klosters Mountains. With five winter sports areas and 250 kilometers of slopes and over 80 different runs, the Davos Klosters Mountains are one of the largest snow sports areas in the Alps.

To support young winter sports enthusiasts, we grant special rates for schools and J&S sports courses as well as camps. The tariffs are applicable if at least 15 mountain railway tickets of the same validity area are purchased for the same duration from the same date. If the class consists of less than 15 students, please send a written request to the appropriate ticket office to verify the purchase.

The special rates apply to all institutions listed below:

- Public and private schools
- Youth & Sports (J&S) support programs and courses

Order handling

The tickets are ordered by mail in the name of the school / J&S group at the latest two days in advance at the selected cashier desk, whereby small adjustments in the number are possible at short notice. J&S groups must also enclose the official course description with the order. The tickets are issued in advance so that the students can get to the ski area quickly.

Pick-up of the tickets

The leaders of the school / J&S group purchase all mountain railway tickets together. Individual issuance is not possible. The tickets will be handed out only at the agreed cashier desk. All ski passes are personal and non-transferable. Leaders are responsible for ensuring that all tickets are distributed in an age-appropriate manner. Random ticket checks will be made at the ski areas.

Validity of the tickets

The regional ski passes are valid on all lifts of the Parsenn Gotschna, Jakobshorn, Rinerhorn, Pischa and Madrisa as well as on the valley ski lifts in Davos and Klosters (without Schatzalp). The valley ski lift Selfranga accepts our regional ski passes only from a 3-day ski pass. Please note the operating times of the individual ski areas.

KeyCard

1- and 2-day ski passes are issued on KeyTickets (one-way paper cards free of charge). All multi-day ski passes are issued in the form of a KeyCard for a deposit of CHF 5.- per card, which must be paid in cash upon collection. The KeyCard must be worn on the left side of the body in order to be recognized by the system.

Loss of tickets

The leaders will receive a receipt with the ticket numbers when they get the tickets. In order to block the old ticket and issue a new one if a ticket is lost, we need the number of the lost ticket. We therefore recommend to write down the names with the numbers on the receipt when giving it to the students or the students take a photo of their personal ski pass with their cell phone right away.

Public transport included

With every valid Davos Klosters Mountains ski pass, public transport is included until 19h in connection with the use as for winter sports (skiing, snowboarding and sledging in corresponding equipment) as follows:

- VBD = Davos local bus network without side valleys (can also be used after 19h)
- OKS = Local bus network Klosters-Serneus only valid for round trips to the valley stations
- Rhätische Bahn RhB 2nd class (Küblis - Filisur), only valid for round trips to the valley stations
