PARADISE FOR PARAGLIDERS

Paragliding pilots find great flying conditions all year round in Davos Klosters thanks to constant thermals. Every dream of flying can come true on a tandem flight with one of the many service providers.

To be as one with the wind, gliding over magnificent mountain scenery – that's flying in Davos Klosters. The many take-off and landing spots make it virtually possible to soar through the air all year round. Jakobshorn is an insiders' tip on the paragliding scene, especially in winter, when snow means that other places have too few thermals (rising currents of air). The forest at the foot of the mountain warms up in the sun and produces the sought-after updraught, much to the delight of all pilots. The Jatz Hut as a take-off point has become synonymous with winter paragliding on sunny winter days. Sun loungers, a whirlpool and a great atmosphere add to its appeal as a meeting point for high-flyers.

Varied flying options

On summer afternoons, the winter thermals on Jakobshorn are replaced by strong valley winds rising along the slopes and giving pilots the opportunity of soaring – flying in the up-currents. In addition to Jakobshorn, Schatzalp and Parsenn are also suitable as take-off points. Those who want to practice distance flying – flying as far as possible – will really be in their element here. Those arriving from the lowlands can already begin flying in Klosters. You can enjoy excellent thermals and conditions for soaring from Gotschnagrät and Madrisa. And you can get a direct link to the Prättigau «Thermal Motorway».

Towards the sun on a tandem flight

Paragliding is far more than a spectacular treat for the eyes. Anyone who would like to fly like a bird over Davos or Klosters can contact one of the tandem-flight providers.

Mountain rail & cableways

The various take-off points are easy to reach from Davos and Klosters with our mountain rail & cableways. A 1-day paragliding pass per mountain costs CHF 49.- and includes unlimited trips and canopy transport. A single trip to Schatzalp costs CHF 8.-.
